Dr. Burns earned her degree in Dental Medicine with honors from the University of Pittsburgh and her Certificate in Orthodontics and Master of Education and Science from the Ohio State University. She received her certificate from the Roth Institute of TMJ Centered Orthodontic Treatment and serves on the faculty of the OBI Foundation for Bioesthetic Dentistry.

In orthodontic practice for over 27 years, Dr. Burns lectures internationally on the topics of Biologic Orthodontics and the role of the Orthodontist in the treatment of patients with sleep disordered breathing. She also serves as a research mentor for Orthodontic Residents at:

Dr. Burns will present a program which will include airway assessment through clinical exam, medical and dental histories and the use of CBCT data. In addition, CBCT assessment of the TMJ and skeletal structures will be demonstrated. A presentation of the spectrum of Sleep Disordered Breathing and a review of the current Medical and Dental literature will enable the participants to bring knowledge of this most critical information into their practice. Finally, Dr. Burns will present strategies to enhance the airway during growth and development and comprehensive dental care. The following is an outline of the presentation:
